

**Corona Regulation**  
**Major changes as of 15.06.2020**



**1.) School operation**

Up to and including 30.06.2020, after-school and afternoon care is prohibited. Please contact your child's school to find out about school operations and the implementation of school examinations. Important: Send your children to school only at the times specified by the school.

**From 29.06.2020 every primary school child will be allowed to go to school again.**

**2.) Day care facilities, primary school support classes and school kindergartens**

Up to and including 30 June 2020, the operation of school kindergartens, primary school remedial classes and day care facilities for children as well as day care for children is prohibited. The rules for extended emergency childcare still apply. Within the framework of emergency childcare, a child may attend a day care centre.

**3.) University operations and university libraries**

Operation at universities is prohibited up to and including 30 June 2020.  
The university libraries may open.

**4.) Collections in public space**

Up to and including 30 June 2020

\* alone

\* or in a group with members of up to two households,

\* but with a maximum of ten people

in public places.

The minimum distance of 1.5 metres still applies to all other persons.

**5.) Collections in private space**

Up to and including 30 June 2020, no more than twenty people are allowed in a private room.

**6.) Mouth and nose protection**

Every person over the age of six must continue to wear a mouth and nose protector when shopping and on public transport (bus, train, boat). This obligation also applies when waiting at train and bus platforms etc.

**7.) Major events**

Large events with more than 500 participants are prohibited until 31 August 2020.

**8.) Initial reception facilities**

Persons admitted to an initial reception centre shall not leave their assigned area for 14 days up to and including 30 June 2020.
